- III. <u>Call to order</u>: Meeting was called to order at 1:12 pm; Introductions were made by the committee; ensuring attendance list was managed and quorum established.
- IV. <u>Approval of the June Meeting Minutes</u>: June meeting minutes were distributed prior to the meeting via email. Elizabeth Heller asked for a motion to approve the minutes as written. Jack Avis seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously without discussion.
- V. Questionnaire Responses Discussion and Next Steps: Jenna Leveille led a discussion about an effort to get information from the Counties regarding their cadastral reference systems and parcel databases. After the last meeting in June, Jenna sent out a questionnaire to all Counties, asking about their cadastral reference systems and parcel databases. We only received responses from 6 counties (Cochise, Coconino, Gila, Pima, Pinal, & Yavapai). Jenna will continue to reach out to the non-responsive counties to try to complete the list. Veronica Nixon will add a question to the questionnaire draft asking if it is ok to republish the county's data.

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- VI. Glossary of Terms Discussion: Elizabeth is working on a 1–2-page glossary of terms that will be a helpful reference when working with people not familiar with Cadastral Mapping.
- VII. <u>Statewide Parcel Efforts:</u> Jenna gave an update from Eric Shreve at the 911 office, saying that language for requirements for Counties to submit parcels to the State for use by State agencies got approved to go to the next legislative session. Veronica mentioned that ADWR started using an address cleansing service and it is saving a lot of time.
- VIII. Parcel Fabric Discussion: Brian Bond is in the process of looking into transitioning Yavapai County to the Parcel Fabric and he led a discussion about the pros and cons and other things to consider when moving to the Parcel Fabric. Jack mentioned that it is important that the County Assessors Office is on board with the decision to move to the fabric and they should work with other County GIS users and share responsibilities.

Veronica Nixon will add a question to the questionnaire draft asking if it is ok to republish the county's data. Jenna will reach out to Eric Shreve to ask if he could attend the next meeting.
