- I. <u>Call to order:</u> Meeting was called to order at 2:32 pm; Introductions were made by the committee ensuring attendance list was managed and quorum established.
- **II.** Approval of Minutes: Motion to approve the minutes was made by Gene and seconded by Steve. Motion passed.
- III. <u>Discuss AGIC Annual Report:</u> Since the last workgroup meeting, Shea and Jenna had created a draft outline format for the annual report and began adding content, such as bullet points for key accomplishments. The workgroup then reviewed the Supporting Arizona section, which will summarize the various work AGIC has done to support Arizona issues. The workgroup began listing various issues and noted some sections would require feedback from subject matter experts, such as Eric Shreve's input for NextGen911 content.

The workgroup discussed and agreed on several suggestions made by the members, including:

- Jenna felt it would be helpful to start grouping the accomplishments under headers that would help people navigate the section.
- Gene suggested splitting the report into two parts, where part 1
  would be intended for executive-level readers, such as state
  representatives and state agency directors, and part 2 would be
  intended for AGIC members that would include more detailed
  information about AGIC in-general and its accomplishments.
- Lucas suggested grouping the accomplishments listed in the Supporting Arizona section to mimic the priorities listed on the
